*NDIS Application Assistance

Navigating the NDIS can be incredibly challenging and overwhelming. At Parkinson's SA we are proud to offer our assistance with helping clients with 'getting on' the NDIS, as well as preparing for their planning meeting.

Clients need to demonstrate functional impairment in multiple domains of daily living to access the NDIS. The 'Application Assessment' involves going through the processes of applying for the NDIS before engaging in a variety of standardised assessments. An occupational therapist will then write a report supporting the client's application to the NDIS.

Fees and Payments

National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS)

Parkinson's SA are able to provide supports for plan-managed and self-managed NDIS participants. Please inform your therapist if you or the person you represent have an NDIS plan prior to your first appointment. At your first appointment you will be required to sign a service agreement in accordance with NDIS guidelines. For more information visit the [National Disability Insurance Scheme](#).

My Aged Care

Individuals with a Home Care Package included in their My Aged Care Plan have the ability to use some of these funds to access allied health services, including Occupational Therapy. Parkinson's SA are able to provide services to individuals with a Home Care Package. For more information visit [My Aged Care](#).

Medicare

Parkinson's SA are able to provide services for people referred under a *Chronic Disease Management Plan* (MBS Code 10958) and a *Mental Health Care Plan* (MBS Code 80135). These plans are arranged by your GP and entitle you respectively to five and ten allied health appointments per calendar year, with a rebate of \$54.60 and \$77.10 respectively. At the completion of the final session, the OT will write a completion summary back to the referring practitioner.
